CY8CKIT-003 PSoC® 3 FirstTouch™ Starter Kit

Release Date: September 6, 2012

Thank you for your interest in the CY8CKIT-003 PSoC® 3 FirstTouch™ Starter Kit. This document lists installation requirements, software and hardware updates, limitations, and known issues with the kit.

System Requirements and Recommendations

There are no Kit specific System Requirements

Installation

To install, insert the kit CD/DVD into your PC's CD/DVD-ROM drive. If the installer does not start automatically, run cyautorun.exe in the root directory of the CD/DVD. Follow the installation instructions.

Notes

- For the latest version of PSoC Programmer, go to www.cypress.com/go/psocprogrammer. If you have a previous installation of PSoC Creator or PSoC Programmer, uninstall the same before reinstalling. To uninstall the software, go to Start > Control Panel > Add or **Remove Programs** and click the **Remove** button adjacent to the particular software. Follow the instructions to uninstall.
- Do not plug in your PSoC 3 FirstTouch Starter Kit to the USB port of the PC until all software installation is complete.

Updates

- Added reverse-voltage and overvoltage protection at expansion ports on 5-V and 3.3-V power lines.
- Added ESD protection on USB lines.

Limitations and Known Issues

- Temperature calibration is not performed for the "ThermistorTemperatureSense" project.
- Vbus sensing and suspend handling are not implemented. This causes the USB Back Voltage test and USB Suspend Current test, required to pass USB Compliance testing, to fail.
- Firmware code examples have been tested with 3.3 V and 5.0 V only.
